The Manx Government is 'exploring' fluoridating our drinking water. This means adding toxic waste products - including arsenic, lead, mercury and radioactive metals - linked to serious adverse health effects in humans and animals.

FLUORIDATING WATER IS NOT PROVEN TO REDUCE TOOTH DECAY.

FLUORIDATING WATER IS LINKED TO SERIOUS ADVERSE HEALTH EFFECTS.

Adverse health effects include bone cancer and fractures, reproductive problems, arthritis, Alzheimer's disease and reduced IQ in children.

There has never been a Randomised Controlled Trial - the 'gold standard' - to show that adding fluoride to water reduces tooth decay.

Fluoridating water is wrong **MEDICALLY**

A report by the US National Research Council identified a number of health risks associated with fluoride exposure.

*"There seems to be limited evidence around water fluoridation with **no randomised controlled trial confirming either safety or efficacy**. In the absence of hard evidence, a precautionary approach seems appropriate.*
